On a Saturday in the summer you would find them at Danceland with friends enjoying the music and dancing the night away. In later years when Dad was playing for the dances, Mom was still there enjoying the music and visiting with friends. Mom was the ultimate hostess, whether it be family celebrations, hockey parties or happy hour patio parties, she always ensured there was plenty of food and drink and enjoyed every minute of it. Out of necessity, Mom moved into the LLVIF in April of 2021 and while this transition wasn't easy, she soldiered on and made the best of it, always offering a smile to residents and staff. Mom's wit and sassy attitude kept the staff on their toes! She continued to take great pride in her everyday appearance as fashion, make-up and jewellery were always a passion.
